

EE 441 HOMEWORK POLICY

1. Homeworks should be submitted at 23:59 latest, on the day they are due.
2. Late submissions are possible, but penalized by 5 pts/day
3. Homeworks should be done individually. Any failed attempt of cheating will result in a 0 grade for all parties involved.
4. Cooperation is not allowed. If detected, it will be regarded as a cheat attempt, and treated accordingly.
5. You will have more than enough time for completing the homeworks, even considering your heavy workload. So, early submission is strongly recommended to avoid last minute problems.
6. All homeworks should be submitted with proper internal and external documentation. A proper external documentation includes:
 - i. Name of the programmer, homework number
 - ii. Purpose of the program.
 - iii. Structure of the program (this part should contain the organization of the program, including a description of the classes, functions and variables)
 - iv. A discussion on the general method of solution, clearly stating the program flow
7. Internal documentation corresponds to the comments in the code. A proper internal documentation includes:
 - i. Purpose of program variables, classes and functions
 - ii. Clarification of the code and how the algorithm is applied, indicating the corresponding parts in the code. Do not hesitate to use comments, the better they get, the better our understanding will be.

CAUTION: A properly running program is necessary, but NOT sufficient for getting full grade unless well-documented. The more detailed your internal and external documentations are, the better the chances that you will get a good grade.

8. You can ask anything short of complete solutions of the homeworks to the assistants. You are strongly recommended to do so. Consider e-mailing, if you cannot meet the assistants in person.
9. Homeworks will be uploaded using METU-Online. Visit online.metu.edu.tr and login with your METU-Webmail accounts. Select EE441 from courses. Homeworks are under Assignments.
